## ECONOMIC VALUE

Municipalities spent \$53.06 per capita - less than 2 seasonal state beach passes.



Borrowing 4 museum passes and only 4 books per year saves a family of four an average of $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0}$ !

## PANDEMIC RECOVERY

Patrons used library computers 275,849 times in FY2022, an increase of 72\% from FY2021.

Libraries reported 579,530 WiFi sessions, an increase of 50\% from FY2021.

## LIBRARY PROGRAMS

During FY22, in-person programs rebounded from pandemicinduced drop!


- 15,906 programs held at libraries - a 310\% increase from FY21.
- 639 library programs held offsite around communities, up from just 100 in FY21.
