
Fall 2019 LORI Delivery Items Count Results

About the Survey

LORI libraries statewide participated in the biannual Delivery Items Count from October 20 through October 26, 2019. 192 library facilities that receive OLIS-LORI Delivery services recorded and reported their out-going item counts. Altogether, 40,812 items were transported in the LORI Delivery system during the week.


Survey Summaries


Of the 40,812 outgoing items, 39,213 (96%) came from public libraries while the remaining 4% came from academic, school, and special libraries.




Overall, the heaviest delivery traffic occurs on Mondays. On Monday, October 21st, 8,403 items were placed in delivery bins to be transported from LORI libraries.

Both the Fall and Spring Item Count results show an increase in volume. This increase is more dramatic and less predictable in the year-over-year Fall results; however, the year-over-year Spring volume remains consistently higher.
