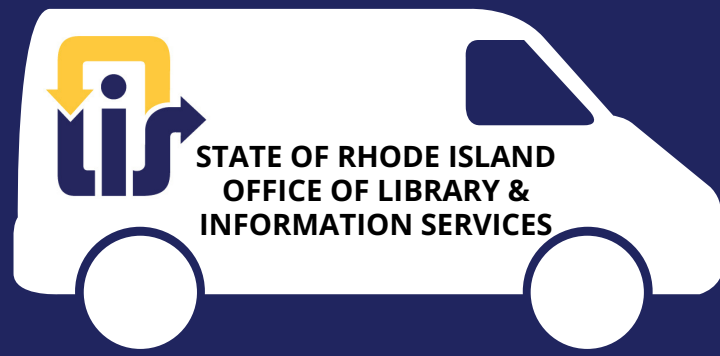


Library of Rhode Island Delivery Item Count

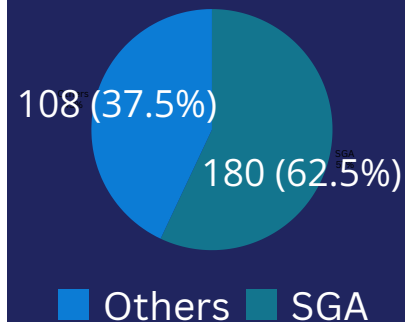

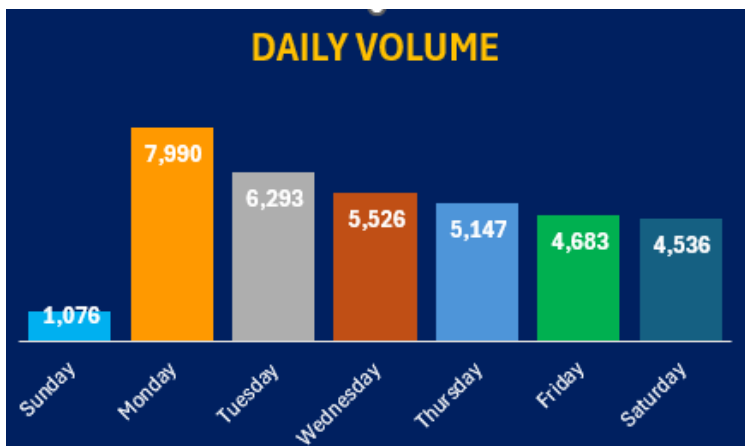

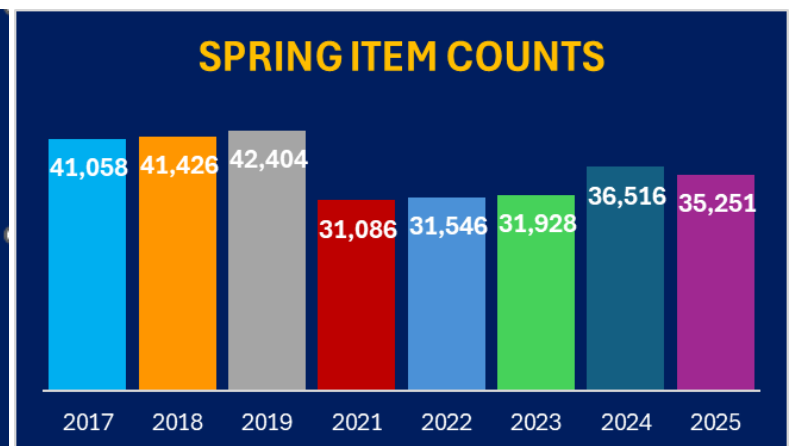
